

Kacper Bartczak – Associate professor of American Literature and Head of the Department of American Literature at the University of Łódź. He is the author of *In Search of Communication and Community: the Poetry of John Ashbery* (Peter Lang, 2006) and *Świat nie scalony* (Biuro Literackie, 2009) for which he received the prize of “Literatura na Świecie.” He is a co-editor (with Małgorzata Myk) of a volume of essays *What Practice After Theory* (2013) and a coeditor (also with Małgorzata Myk) of the 2017 special issue of PJAS on formal innovation in poetry. He has received Fulbright junior and senior awards, and the Kościuszko Foundation scholarship. He is a translator of poetry and has translated into Polish the work of John Ashbery, Peter Gizzi (a joint book publication, with Andrzej Sosnowski, from Instytut Mikołowski in 2013), and Rae Armantrout. He is also a poet in Polish, and his 2015 volume, *Wiersze organiczne*, was nominated to two major Polish literary prizes, the *Silesius* and *Gdynia* awards. A book collection of his translations of Rae Armantrout’s poems will be published by Biuro Literackie next year.
