New Orleans-born trumpeter Michael "Patches" Stewart is a jazz solo artist who has also worked with American music luminaries such as Quincy Jones, Whitney Houston, Al Jarreau, Diana Ross, George Duke, and Marcus Miller. His work also includes collaborations with Polish jazz stars Michał Urbaniak and Henryk Miśkiewicz.

Following years in the Los Angeles music business, Mr. Stewart currently lives in Warsaw. He will discuss the roots of jazz in New Orleans, trace the development of the music right up to the present day and perform live jazz improvisations. His brand new CD "On Fire" features collaborations between leading Polish musicians and well-known American jazz stars.
