### **EXPLANATIONS:**

• All **grades** and credits are **reported** and recognized **at the end of each academic year**. The total of ECTS points required in two semesters is 60. It means that even though some students fail their exams in the winter exam session, they should submit the request for conditional pass (up to 20 ECTS points missing), or repeating the year (over 20 ECTS points missing or the 3<sup>rd</sup> year of studies) only after they secure all the grades for the classes required in the summer semester.

- Students are required to get credit for the Health and Safety in the Workplace course (BHP) and Intellectual Property Protection (POWI) or submit a document certifying the completion of such courses at their earlier study programs at the University (if they have any).
- Elective courses (9 altogether) start in the second semester of the program. Students pick them according to their interests. All electives are assigned either to Humanities (H) or Social Sciences (S), sometimes both. Students can see this in USOS before registration. It is important because each student is obliged to complete at least 2 electives from each group. It means, 2 electives from Humanities (H) and 2 electives from Social Sciences (S) + the remaining 5 from any group.
- **Foreign Language Classes** start in the second year. Students have to secure **4 semesters** of language classes (4 x 60 hours/semester) in the language other than English. They can be taken earlier (eg. in the first year) but have to be reported in accordance with the program: two at the end of the second year and two at the end of the third year of studies. Students usually sign up for both semesters of language in the fall registration. It means they join a group in October and stay in the same one for the spring semester. Changes are possible but they have to be arranged at a proper time. Students do not have to have 4 semesters of the same language, just four semesters of a foreign language other than English.
- Language Certification Exam can be taken at any point of studies but no later than the end of the sixth semester. Moreover, there is no correlation between the foreign language taken and the exam. It means, a student may learn one foreign language during the studies and pass a B2 Certification exam in another, eg. the one a student learnt in high school. Both language classes and B2 Exam are restricted to languages other than English. The Certification Exam can also be taken in English at the minimum level C1.
- **Physical Education** classes start in the second semester of the first year. Students may take them earlier but cannot leave their passing till further in the studies. By the end of the first year students should report taking and passing one Physical Education class and two more by the end of the second year of studies.
- OGUN classes can be attended at any point in the studies but they must be reported in accordance with the program requirements. It means each student has to report min 3
   ECTS points for OGUN at the end of the fourth semester and another 6 ECTS points at the end of the sixth semester. The total ECTS requirement for OGUN is 9 for BA studies. The number of courses taken to fulfill the requirement does not matter. Students may take one OGUN for 9 ECTS points or three OGUNs for 3 ECTS points.
- OZN points should be collected throughout the entire course of studies, yet, they are
  reported and recognized at the end of the sixth semester. The earlier students start
  collecting them, the better. Our ASC website and social media provide information about
  offered events students may attend.
