EXPLANATIONS:

- All grades and credits are reported and recognized at the end of each academic year. The total of ECTS points required in two semesters is 60.
- Students seeking to complete the Latin America and the Caribbean specialization are required to get credit for Spanish language, a senior research lecture belonging to the specialization, and develop an MA thesis in the area of Latin American and Caribbean studies.
- OZN points can be collected throughout the whole two-year program, and are reported and recognized at the end of the fourth semester.
- OGUN classes can be attended at any point in the studies but they must be reported in the fourth semester. Students may attend courses with fewer ECTS points than required or one with 6 (or more) ECTS points. Choice is based on student's interest. The sum of points for OGUN classes has to be minimum 6 ECTS.
